#### COMPASS

Our Compass Kiosk has been a great success. The Kiosk sits in the front office and looks like a large iPad. Parents who pick up their child/ren early or late arrivals simply sign their child in/out on the Kiosk and the class roll is amended. Please note, because the roll is a legal document only parents can use the kiosk. If a child arrives late without a parent they need to report to the office.

Today you will have received details about a Compass Parent Portal and App which will enable you to access information online about your child/ren, anytime, anywhere, from any modern web-enabled device.

Keep a look out for the email with login information and instructions. Please download the App as soon as you receive the details to avoid forgetting to do so later. Initially the App will allow you to

· View information on your child/ren's attendance



- Enter explanations for absences
- Receive communications
- Update your contact details

From today you will no longer need to phone the office to inform us of your child's absence or send in a note on the child's return. You will simply log onto the App and register the absence yourself. No further action will be required. If you haven't registered the absence by 9:30am you will receive an SMS informing you that your child has not arrived at school and you will need to log onto the Compass App to explain the absence.
