CEREMONY OF LIGHT

Thank you to the many families who joined us to welcome in the new year last Friday. It was a lovely way to start the year. Congratulations

to our new student leaders and welcome to all who have joined St Cecilia's for the first time. Fr John reminded us to let our light shine in our dealings with each other and not let it go out.

ABSENCE

It is important to understand that attending school is a legal requirement. This includes arrIving on time and staying until the end of the school day. Where possible it is important to make doctors appointments, plan holidays etc ouside of school time. On occasion these appointments are unavoidable. Please feel free to discus such occassions with me. It is also important to remember to fill in late arrival forms if your child is late to school, or is picked up early, giving a valid reason. Without a valid reason the leave has to be recorded as unjustified. Always follow up an absence with a written note. Finally please be aware we cannot approve time away from school to attend outside turtoring during school time. This falls under Diocesan directives and an accumilation of unjustified leave must be reported.

SWIMMING CARNIVAL

The 2019 School Swimming Carnival for Years 2 - 6 is on tomorrow, at Manly Swimming Centre Balgowlah Road, Manly. Entry into races has now closed. Children not entered into an event cannot enter on the day as the online form doubles as permission from the parent for the child to enter the water. Without this consent prior to the carnival we cannot let your child enter the water. It is OK for a child who is entered into race not to swim if they change their mind. The carnival will run from 9:00 – 11:30am. **Parents transport their own children to the pool**. At the conclusion of the swimming carnival, buses will transport children back to school. It is a regular school day and school will continue as usual in the afternoon.

Ribbons will be awarded at assembly next Monday once the overall 50 metre event winners (not for the winners of heats) have been determined based on times collected. Please take the time to explain this to your child to avoid disappointment on the day.

Please note: Kindergarten and Year 1 do not attend the carnival. They will attend school as usual

TAKING OF MEDICINE AT SCHOOL

All schools within the Diocese of Broken Bay must follow set guidelines for the administering of medication in school.

Of high importance:

- medication needs to be sent to school in its original packaging
- all medication needs to be accompanied by a note giving the school permission to administer the medication
- prescribed medication must be clearly labelled with the dispensing sticker that notes the name of the child, name and phone number of prescribing Doctor, medicine to be taken, dosage and frequency
- all 'over the counter medication' must be accompanied by the <u>form</u> available on our webpage. This form also needs to be signed by a doctor
- without such written permission and clear instructions, no medication will be given to any student.
- for the safety of all students, under no circumstances is medication to be sent to the school in the child's bag.
