

# Headache

*(suitable for all grades)*



1. Min 3 players - one player is the 'dealer' who draws cards and puts them on the other players' foreheads without them seeing what their card/s are.
2. Dealer adds the total of all the cards and tells the other players what the total is.
3. The players then have to look at the other players cards to help figure out what their card/s total is.
  - Additional option: Ace = 11 / King, Queen, Jack = 12

## Adaptations

- 3 players, 1 dealer, 1 card for each player
- 3 players, 1 dealer, 2 cards for each player
- 4 players, 1 dealer, 1 card each for each player
- 4 players, 1 dealer and 2 cards for each player
- 5 players, 1 dealer and 1 card for each player
- 5 players, 1 dealer and 2 cards for each player
- Use the 3 player options but **multiply** the values on the cards instead so that students need to find the factors or multiple that fits
