MID-YEAR REPORTS

Teachers have finalised semester one progress reports for all students. These will be emailed to you next week on Friday 22 June. These interviews will involve yourself, your child and their teacher. They are an opportunity to discuss your child's learning. ATHLETICS CARNIVAL WEDNESDAY 20 JUNE

This year the Athletics Carnival will be held on Wednesday 20 June at the Narrabeen Academy of Sports (Wakehurst Parkway, Narrabeen) between 9:30 – 1:30pm. The Athletics Carnival involves all children from Kindergarten to Year 6 and is a great opportunity for all those involved in the school community to enjoy the unique community spirit at St Cecilia's Catholic school.

Students are required to wear full sports uniform to the Athletics Carnival. The children will also need their hats, morning tea, lunch and plenty of water. Students will not be given time to go to the canteen so it is best that they bring everything they require for the day.

Spikes are permitted in 100m and 200m events. For safety reasons, students must put on and take off their spikes before/after each race. To be eligible for age champion, students need to compete in at least four events across track and field.
