GALA DINNER

After many hours of preparation by our amazing Year 2 parents, the Gala Dinner is organised and promises to be a night to 'come alive'. You should receive your invitations to the event today. We are very grateful to all of our sponsors who are supporting us this year. Some have sponsored us for a number of years whilst others are new this year. Last year the Gala Dinner allowed us to introduce coding lessons from Years 1 to 6, purchase Beet Bots robots for kindergarten, hold more science incursions and resource the school with technology. In the past, Gala Dinner fundraising has paid for the Secret Garden, new readers for the younger grades, the flexible learning space for the upper grades as well as a shade structure in the Secret Garden, our PA system, iPads for all grades and fans in the hall.

This year we plan to use the money to build a shade structure over the basketball court and a smaller one over the sand pit. We also hope to continue coding lessons in Years 1 to 6 and provide more learning experiences in line with STEM.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION MODULE: Stage 1—Year 2: ‘Confirmation’

In complement to the Parish Sacramental Program, Year 2 students will explore the **Sacrament of Confirmation** as completing **Baptism**. The module introduces students to the Sacrament of Confirmation, which challenges them to **listen** and be more **open to the Spirit**, as they hear again Jesus’ message and call to **discipleship**. Students will research, reflect on and recall the signs and symbols particular to Confirmation. Students begin to explore the **gifts of the Spirit** and how it helps them live their lives.




