Fr John Frauenfelder's Words of Wisdom – 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time: 2 September 2018

Like Tevye's image of a fiddler on the rooftop, we can find ourselves trying to simply live our lives balancing precariously between tradition and love. It can be much easier to live by someone else's set of rules than to obey and follow God. Tevye argues frequently with this demanding, counter-intuitive and tenacious God, but love won.

Jesus gave us a new tradition that begins and ends with love. He asks us to let love transform our hearts and our souls so that we transform the world. In the tradition of love, are we willing to climb down from the rooftop and scratch out our simple, pleasant tune grounded in God?

Last night our Diocese launched the following commitment to Safeguarding during a liturgy of Commitment and Care at the Cathedral.


We the people of the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay are committed to fostering communities of safety and care for all people especially for children and others in the community who are vulnerable.


'FAMILIES COME GATHER' MASSES


