Advent begins this Sunday 2 December. Over the next three weeks all classes will be focusing on Advent leading to Christmas. The liturgical season of Advent will be explored as a time of waiting and preparation for the celebration of the coming of the Messiah. The people of the Old Testament waited, Joseph and Mary waited and so we too wait in anticipation.

### Early Stage 1—Kindergarten

• For Advent: The focus of Advent in this module is the annunciation. The announcement to Mary that she would be the mother of Jesus shows that God is active in the lives of ordinary people, and thus is active in our own lives.



For Christmas: Christmas will be seen as a time that opens up possibilities for us to change as people. The infancy
narratives will be explored in the context of what they say to us as disciples of Jesus. Christmas celebrates God's
transformative power in the person of Jesus. The acts of giving, receiving and celebrating open us up to
transformation and to transforming the lives of others.

### SHARE THE DIGNITY

This year Neneh, Zoe and I are coordinating a collection for the *Share the Dignity* campaign and we would really appreciate your support.

On any given night in Australia, 1 in 200 people are homeless. 44% are female. 27% are children under the age of 18. Family violence is the number one reason people present to homeless services. 55% of females cite this reason. We really would love your help.

When you donate to *Share the Dignity*, you're donating much more than personal care items. You're giving a woman experiencing homelessness or financial crisis the essentials, so she doesn't need to choose between food and dignity.

It's a simple act of kindness – filling a preloved handbag or backpack with life essentials (think shampoo & conditioner, soap, deodorant, sanitary items etc.) and they are then distributed to shelters for women in need. We may be given many things this Christmas, however for many of the women and girls in the shelters this may well be the only thing they receive.
