


Bingo...with variations

(suitable for all grades)



- Go to <http://myfreebingocards.com/numbers>
- Print off Bingo cards relevant to your child's grade – **for example** – a Year 1 student may have the 0-20 set while a Year 4 may use the 0-90 cards
- Or children can create their own numbers by drawing a 3x3 or 4x4 array template or larger and writing their own numbers in the squares
- Call numbers you generate by rolling dice or similar, or use an online bingo number caller

Some adjustments or extras

- Play more/less bingo – eg, playing 2 more/less bingo means the child has to not only look for the number that comes up but also the number that is 2 more and 2 less (eg the bingo number is 36, so students look for 36, 34 and 38)
- Include larger numbers in the bingo range use greater more/less values, eg, range between 710 and 800, if you roll 768, children have to find and cross out 768 as well as the values that are 20 more/less, eg, 748 and 788
