#### Do we allow our lives to get 'caught up' with Jesus?

The story of Zacchaeus is a beautiful example of how our lives can get 'caught up' with Jesus, even when we don't mean to, even when we take hesitant steps, and even before our lives are perfectly in order. Zacchaeus is not an honest man, but something draws him to Jesus and he climbs a tree to get a better look as Jesus comes near. The story continues with Jesus inviting himself into Zacchaeus' home. The crowd complains, but the Scripture text tells us that Zacchaeus "stood his ground"; he states publicly his intention to reform his life. Jesus affirms his courage and declares that Zacchaeus too is one of God's family, "a son of Abraham". (See Luke 19:1-10.)

#### **Dear Parents**



Last Thursday our SRC (Yrs 3 -6) attended the Diocesan Mission Mass along with the other schools of our Diocese.

This year, students across Australia are encouraged to learn about how the Church in Ghana is taking a lead in providing life-saving care to children with a disability and fostering their personal development for a brighter future. In Ghana there are many children who go to school, hang out with friends and family, and do fun things like sport. Distressingly, some children, especially those with a disability, struggle to have their basic needs met, such as nutritious food and clean water, healthcare, education and safety. We were able to give a donation

to Catholic Mission from the proceeds taken from Millie Smith to help support these children.

We were pleasantly surprised to have Bishop Elect Anthony Randazzo join us at the Mass. Bishop Randazzo will be officially installed as the fourth Bishop of the Broken Bay Diocese on the 4 November. The Bishop was not expected at the Mass but he said he couldn't pass up the opportunity to meet the children of the Diocese.
