Religious Education

Inquiry question: How does the Sacrament of Penance reconcile me to God, myself and others?

This week in Religious Education we explored the Scriptural reading of Zacchaeus, discussing what this teaches us about Jesus and his challenge to us and disciples.

English

In writing we have been planning and drafting an imaginative text with the picture prompt *The Box* (3W) and *The Chest* (3B).

Success criteria

- adverbs
- adjectives
- sizzling start
- spelling

In spelling we looked at the phoneme /c/ /x/ /q/ and the grapheme /ch/. In our reading groups we have been concentrating on expression and fluency. Our oral presentations have begun and students have confidently stood in front of the class to deliver their speeches.



Mathematics

Students have been placing numbers of up to four digits in ascending and descending order and identifying the number before and after a given two-, three- or four-digit number.

In addition and subtraction students are using place value to partition numbers in standard and non-standard forms.

eg 2500 + 670: 2500 + 600 + 70 = 3170 eg 500 + 670: 670 = 500 + 170, so 500 + 670 = 500 + 500 + 170, which is 1000 + 170 = 1170


<u>History:</u>
