Dear Parents

Over the past week I have tried to connect with all families either over the phone or in person as they have come to collect home packs from school. Parents agree teachers have worked hard and have done a tremendous job so far in transforming how schooling and learning looks. The positivity conveyed by all families is uplifting. Whilst we all understand these are unprecedented times and whilst it can be difficult at times, we know we are in this together.

By tomorrow all children will have connected with their teachers via Zoom meetings. As one parent said to me on the phone, 'who would have thought my 6 year old would have a scheduled Zoom meeting to attend?' These are indeed unique times!

Many parents have asked how long the remote learning will continue. All I can say is 'as a staff we are preparing for the worst and hoping for the best'. At the moment it appears that next term will be very much like it is now.

The allocated pupil free days this week have provided the opportunity for teachers to review the work done in transitioning to Remote Home Based Learning and reflect on the experience of students, parents and teachers before planning for Term 2.

Teachers are

- working on overviews for next term's learning to give to parents
- recording explicit teaching of new concepts for the students
- recording workshops for parents
- planning regular Zoom meeting with small groups
- exploring ways to provide more verbal instructions

At this stage the younger students will continue to receive a combination of home packs and online tasks next term. Students in year 2-6 will continue to receive their learning online, some of which will require printing. Please email the office if you are unable to print at home and prefer to collect a home pack from school.



Once a book is completed it is preferable to enter it straight away onto the student's online reading record. This will encourage students to keep reading as they see their personal list grow. Younger students will require an adult to help log their books.

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

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


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
